## FIND a SPONSOR

## Tips for finding a sponsor

### Be well prepared

Be sure you have all the information you need and you know what you want from the sponsor. Find out if that organization sponsored participants last year. *HINT: Check out our website! Practice your request on someone you trust.*

### Give them all the information that's important

Tell them all about the program, the week you want to attend, the amount of sponsorship you need etc. Show them this brochure!

### Offer to give something back

Past participants have given written and oral reports at meetings or have volunteered for their sponsoring organization. Give the sponsor a chance to learn about what you did at the program. Don't make commitments you won't keep.

### Leave a great impression

Even if the organization doesn't decide to sponsor you, be polite and courteous. Thank them for taking the time to listen to your request. The same organization might decide to sponsor you or someone else next year.

Refunds requested with notice of two weeks or more will be subject to an \$89.25 fee withheld to cover administrative costs.

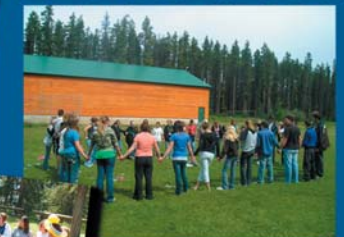
